**Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick:** Anyone in danger of death or the elderly should receive this sacrament. Anyone anticipating a surgery or a stay in the hospital should request the sacrament before surgery.

This week's featured Lighthouse CD is The Fourth Cup by Scott Hahn: Well-known Catholic theologian Dr. Scott Hahn explains Christ's Paschal Sacrifice on the cross as the fulfillment of the traditional fourth cup used in the celebration of the Jewish Passover meal. He draws a symbolic parallel to the Last Supper and Christ's death on Calvary. Through his scholarly insights and important biblical connections, Mass will come alive for you as never before!

Dr Hahn is a educational theologian. Listening to him always enlightens me in our faith, my spiritual journey but most of all in God. In this CD he sheds light on God's passion in a way that most of us did not recognize in the scriptures. The CD is titled The Fourth-Cup, apparently each time Jesus takes a drink of wine and up His passion there is a deeper that will be brought o the light when you listen to this CD.
