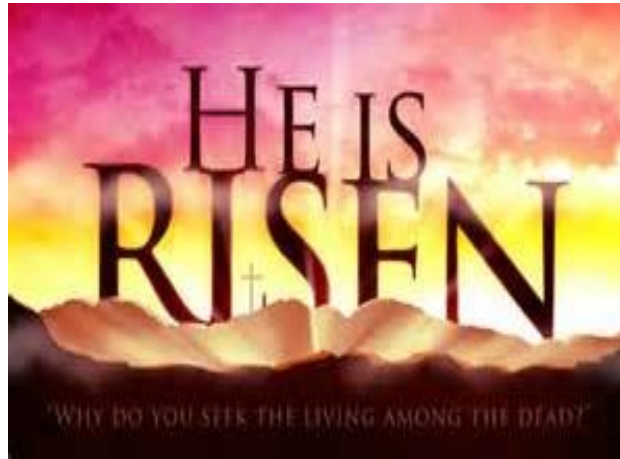

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** Church law directs that Catholics receive marriage preparation and be married in the Church. Please contact the office at least four months prior to the wedding. Advent and lent are penitential Seasons: weddings are discouraged during these seasons.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptism should take place A.S.A.P. following birth. Expectant parents should contact the office for baptismal preparation.

**Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick:** Anyone in danger of death or the elderly should receive this sacrament. Anyone anticipating a surgery or a stay in the hospital should request the sacrament before surgery.

**Confessions available each night after the talk**

**Wednesday evening:** the Subject is Christ. It is a proclamation of the wonder of His Divine and human love. We must understand his greatness of His Divinity and the intimacy of His humanity if we hope to embrace Him. All of us need to be re-evangelized, to be shocked at how deeply and strongly God feels about us.

**Thursday evening:** we reflect on how we must share the wonderful love of God for us with one another. God is love and the person without love knows nothing of God. This night is a practical effort to infuse Christ like love into our families. A deeper love and respect in our homes will give us an experience of God that will take away our breath!

**Friday evening:** we take a deep Biblical look at sin which both destroys us and our love ones! It is the most dangerous virus in the world. Sin severs us from the kiss of God. It destroys our relationship with God. But Christ came to take away our sins and to give us that overwhelming joy of hope.

The mission will try to explore the most beautiful thing a person can do in life. We will talk about our encounter with Christ in prayer. Pope Francis exhorts us: “ I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailing each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her, since “no one is excluded from the joy brought by the Lord”

**Week Day Mass Change**

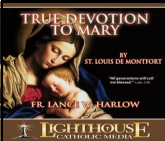

**This week's featured CD is True Devotion to Mary by Father**

**Lance Harlow**: The intercession of our Blessed Mother is especially important for our troubled times. St. Louis de Montfort's classic work on Marian consecration, True Devotion to Mary, provides a well-trod path to the profound graces that the Lord offers through Mary's prayers for those who trust in her intercession.
