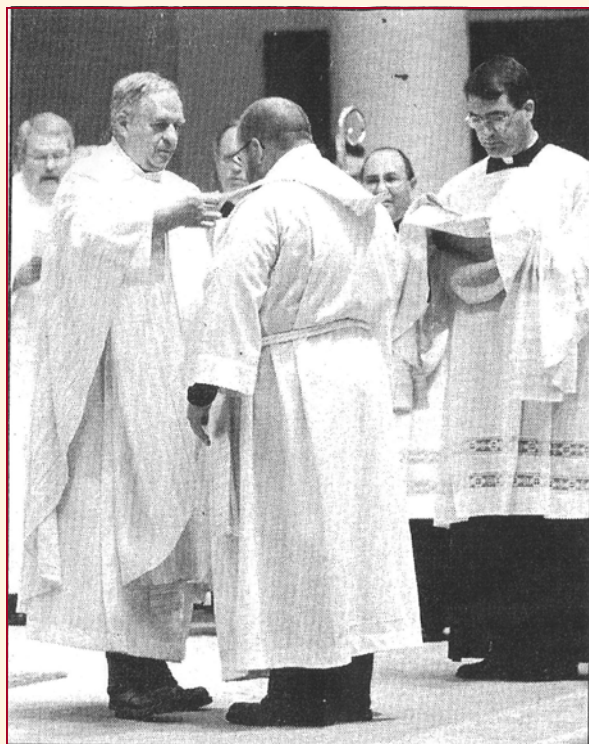
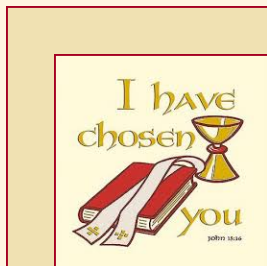
Sacrament of Baptism: Baptism should take place A.S.A.P. following birth. Expectant parents should contact the office for baptismal preparation.

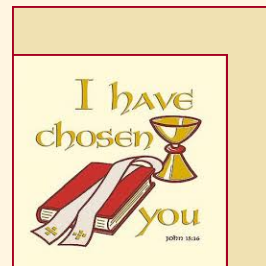
Religious Education Classes [CCD]: Is available for Grades Pre-K-10 10:00 am on Sundays in the Fellowship Hall.

Potluck/Celebration Sunday, June 14, Immediately following 11:30 Mass

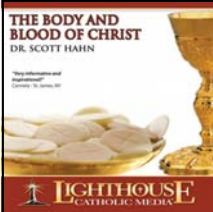

The feast of Corpus Christi [Latin for Body of Christ], also known as Corpus Domini, is a Latin Rite liturgical solemnity celebrating the tradition and belief in the body and blood of Jesus Christ and his Real Presence in the Eucharist. It emphasizes the joy of the institution of the Eucharist, which was observed on Holy Thursday in the somber atmosphere of the nearness of Good Friday.



This week's featured Lighthouse CD is The Body and Blood of Christ.

In this informative presentation, Dr. Scott Hahn, a former Presbyterian minister, provides the biblical basis for the Church's teaching on the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the significance of the Feast of Corpus Christi, and gives us a greater understanding of our vocation to be the living presence of Christ in the world.

This CD is perfect for Corpus Christi. Scott gives an informative talk about the Holy Eucharist. He tells us what he found out during his research into the Catholic faith and how he came to the conclusion that the Eucharist is Jesus. If you have any doubt of the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, then this CD is for you.

They will be ordained at 10:30 a.m. Friday, June 12, the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, at the Cathedral of the Incarnation. The men to be ordained include: Deacons Eric Johansen and Ben Butler, (Notre Dame Seminary); Deacons Andy Bulso and Austin Gilstrap, (North American College in Rome); and Deacon Emmanuel Dirichukwu, (Assumption Seminary).
