<u>New to the Parish? Welcome!</u> To register as a parishioner of St Elizabeth Ann Seton Church, please contact the office.

<u>Sacrament of Matrimony</u>: Church law directs that Catholics receive marriage preparation and be married in the Church. Please contact the office at least four months prior to the wedding. Advent and lent are penitential Seasons: weddings are discouraged during these seasons.

<u>Sacrament of Baptism:</u> Baptism should take place A.S.A.P. following birth. Expectant parents should contact the office for baptismal preparation.

<u>Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick</u>: Anyone in danger of death or the elderly should receive this sacrament. Anyone anticipating a surgery or a stay in the hospital should request the sacrament before surgery.

**Religious Education Classes [CCD]**: Is available for Grades Pre-K-10 10:00 am on Sundays in the Fellowship Hall.



All parents of children K and up are invited to register their children for the Parish Religious Education sessions.

Have questions about whether or not your child should register for Religious Education? St Elizabeth Ann Seton's Rel. Ed. program is for children in Kindergarten through 10th grade who do not attend a Catholic school. The sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion are celebrated for the first time in 2nd grade. The sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in 8th grade. These sacramental preparation classes are two year programs meaning a child should start in 1st grade in order to make their first Reconciliation and First Holy Communion toward the end of the 2nd grade year. Preparation for Confirmation begins in a student's 7th grade year. If a child isn't here the year before the 2<sup>nd</sup> or the 8<sup>th</sup> grade they will need to attend another year to receive their sacrament

Registration forms for the 2017-2018 Religious Ed are available on the table in the Vestibule. There will be a cost this year of \$10.00 per child. Monetary aid can be provided if needed. Sunday classes before Mass at 10:00am will begin August 27. If you have any questions please call Valerie at 931-721-3769

Please register your child as soon as possible so the proper amount of books can be purchased before the first day of Religious Ed.
