Transfiguration of the Lord

New to the Parish? Welcome! To register as a parishioner of St Elizabeth Ann Seton Church, please contact the office.

Sacrament of Matrimony: Church law directs that Catholics receive marriage preparation and be married in the Church. Please contact the office at least four months prior to the wedding. Advent and lent are penitential Seasons: weddings are discouraged during these seasons.

Sacrament of Baptism: Baptism should take place A.S.A.P. following birth. Expectant parents should contact the office for baptismal preparation.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick: Anyone in danger of death or the elderly should receive this sacrament. Anyone anticipating a surgery or a stay in the hospital should request the sacrament before surgery.

Religious Education Classes [CCD]: Is available for Grades Pre-K-10 10:00 am on Sundays in the Fellowship Hall.



All parents of children K and up are invited to register their children for the Parish Religious Education sessions. **Have questions about whether or not your child should register for Religious Education?** St Elizabeth Ann Seton's Rel. Ed. program is for children in Kindergarten through 10th grade who do not attend a Catholic school. The sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion are celebrated for the first time in 2nd grade. The sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in 8th grade. These sacramental preparation classes are two year programs meaning a child should start in 1st grade in order to make their first Reconciliation and First Holy Communion toward the end of the 2nd grade year. Preparation for Confirmation begins in a student's 7th grade year. If a child isn't here the year before the 2nd or the 8th grade they will need to attend another year to receive their sacrament.

Registration forms for the 2017-2018 Religious Ed are available on the table in the Vestibule. There will be a cost this year of \$10.00 per child. Monetary aid can be provided if needed. Sunday classes before Mass at 10:00am will begin August 27. If you have any questions please call Valerie at 931-721-3769

If your child attended CCD last year there is no need to fill out everything on the registration form. All that would be needed if your address, contact information and any changes from last year.

Please register your child as soon as possible so the proper amount of books can be purchased before the first day of Religious Ed.

Why Jesus Wanted to Keep the Transfiguration Secret

Why were the disciples not allowed to tell anyone about the Transfiguration? Only Peter, James, and John witnessed our Lord's Transfiguration—a prefigurement of his resurrected glory (Matt. 17:1-8). Afterward, Jesus forbade them to discuss this event until after he had risen from the dead (Matt. 17:9).

In his commentary on the Gospel of St. Matthew in *A Catholic Commentary on Holy Scripture*, Fr. A. Jones argues:

The glory passes and Jesus is once more the familiar friend. He enjoins silence: the vision is not to be spoken of until after the Resurrection, presumably to avoid premature and mistaken Messianic enthusiasm. Few, knowing of the Transfiguration, would learn to appreciate the necessity of the cross

How Did the Disciples Recognize Moses and Elijah at the Transfiguration?

At the Transfiguration, the apostles seemed to know that the persons conversing with Jesus were Moses and Elijah. How?

The Gospels do not explain how the disciples were able to recognize Moses and Elijah, so any answer is a guess.

Possible ways the disciples were able to recognize Moses and Elijah:

- Jesus referred to them by name in his conversation with them, and the disciples overheard it.
- The disciples overheard the conversation, and the context informed them with whom Jesus was speaking.
- They had something unique about their appearance that made them readily recognizable (Exodus 34:29; 2 Kings 1:8).
- There was some sort of heavenly announcement that wasn't recorded in the Gospels.
- Jesus explained to the disciples who they were.

They were divinely inspired to recognize them, similar to God's revelation to Peter that Jesus is the messiah.
